2 釜山+庆州 (午晚餐)

◆ **佛国寺+石窟庵** 新罗文化的核心和佛教艺术的经典，是世界文化遗产。石窟庵是一个附属于佛国寺的庵，是亚洲最好的佛教圣地之一，还有一尊祥和的佛陀石像注视着东海。



◆ **瞻星台** 是东方现存的最古老的天文台，建于新罗27代王善德女王时期(632~647年)，用于观测天空中的云气及星座。

◆ **普门湖** 整个庆州到处都是樱花树，在百花盛开的春天，普门湖周边樱花盛放，微风拂过，一场“樱花雪”把这里点缀的异常美丽壮观。(赏樱胜地)

4 釜山 (早午晚餐)

◆ **庆和火车站** 位于镇海的小火车站，樱花季时铁轨两旁的樱花树满开，风一吹，数千朵樱花随风飘扬的景色十分迷人，千万不可错过樱花大道!(赏樱胜地)   



◆ **余佐川樱花径** 是条流经镇海市区的小川，小川两旁的樱花树林立，盛开时形成一条粉白色的樱花隧道，是来到镇海赏樱的必访景点之一!(赏樱胜地)   



◆ **金海洛东江铁路自行车** 全长约3公里。路程平缓，让您能边享受微风轻拂边欣赏洛东江沿岸的美丽景色，横跨洛东江上的旧铁桥使风景更添特色。



◆ **红酒隧道** 利用山洞改建的红酒洞窟，新鲜感十足!

◆ **广安大桥** 韩国最大的横跨大海的海上桥梁，车游周边风光。

◆ **海云台迎月路** 樱花满开的迎月路美丽得让人移不开眼，现代感的建筑物和咖啡厅搭配樱花让人眼睛为之一亮。(赏樱胜地) 



◆ 人参公卖局、护肝宝展卖店、韩流时尚彩妆店

◆ **西面地下街** 有着贩售服饰、鞋类的店家，购物的好去处。

1 Kuala Lumpur → Busan (MEAL ON BOARD)

◆ Assemble at KLIA 2, depart flight to Busan.

2 Busan → Gyeongju (L,D)

◆ **Bulguksa & Seokguram** contains a monumental statue of the Buddha looking at the sea in the bhumisparsha mudra position. The Temple of Bulguksa (built in 774) and the Seokguram Grotto form a religious architectural complex of exceptional significance.



◆ **Cheomseongdae** oldest existing astronomical observatory in Asia. Constructed during the reign of Queen Seondeok (632-647), it was used for observing the stars in order to forecast the weather.

◆ **Bomun Lake** When spring arrives, the whole cityscape turns pink with the beautiful blossoms. The combination of the stunning trees reflected in the waters of Bomunho Lake and the trees of Bulguksa Park gracefully adorning the nearby temple make for particularly stunning sights.

3 Gyeongju → Jinhae → Gimhae → Busan (B,L,D)

◆ **Gyeonghwa Station** One of the most beautiful cherry blossom viewing sites in Korea and there are rows of cherry trees along the abandoned railroad, creating an amazing view.



◆ **Yeojwacheon Stream (Cherry Blossom Road)** Each April the whole city of Jinhae is filled with cherry blossoms, but the Yeojwa Stream has the most beautiful cherry blossoms which makes it a prime tourist attraction.



◆ **Gimhae Nakdonggang River Rail Bike** it runs for about 3km in distance and you may enjoy nakdonggang river's beautiful view while riding on the rail bike.



◆ **Wine Cave** Gimhae is famous for raspberries and inside the cave, you can taste and buy a sweet delicious wine!

4 Busan (B,L,D)

◆ **Oryukdo Skywalk** Iron columns were set up over a 35-meter-high coastal cliff, the bottom of the glass was specially produced, visitors will be thrilled with the view of the waves while looking down through the transparent floor.



◆ **Gamcheon Culture Village** is formed by houses built in staircase-fashion on the foothills of a coastal mountain, earning this village the nickname of "Machu Picchu of Busan." The many alleys cutting through this community are vibrantly decorated with murals and sculptures created by the residents.



◆ **Yongdusan Park** a mountain with a view of the sea through the dense pine tree forest. Viewing of the landmark Busan Tower also.



◆ **Jagalchi Market** is Korea's largest seafood market, selling both live and

dried fish. This market represents Busan and is famous throughout the country. If you visit you can eat fresh raw fish right at the market.

◆ **BIFF** is one of the most significant film festivals in Asia. There have a lot of local food to try.

5 Busan (B,L,D)

◆ **Taejongdae** Featuring its highest peak at 250 meters, Taejongdae is also famous for the ritual of praying for rain, performed when there are droughts, and rain on the 10th day of the fifth lunar month is called the "Taejong Rain."



◆ **Gwangandaegyo Bridge** the longest bridge over the ocean in Korea.

◆ **Dalmaji-gil Road (Cherry Blossom Road)** head up Dalmaji-gil Road for views over the bay, pine trees and cherry blossoms galore. Known as a place for lovers all year round, cherry blossom season makes it an even more romantic destination.



◆ **National Ginseng Shop, Cosmetic Shop, Healthy Liver Centre**

◆ **Seomyeon Underground Shopping Center** this underground shopping area has a greater number of clothing.
