### 2 千岁🚗登别🚗洞爷湖 (午晚餐)

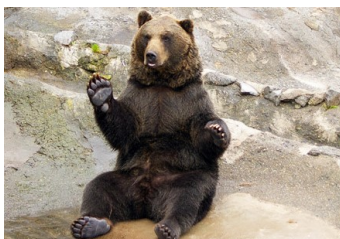
◆ 忍者表演 时代村内以忍者堡垒为舞台而展开的忍者节目表演。

◆ 白老爱奴民族博物馆 爱奴民族(阿伊努)是北海道原住民，博物馆重建了一个户外爱奴小村庄，真实展示了阿伊努人的文化和生活方式。博物馆里整天都会举办一些表演，诸如阿伊努人传统舞蹈、乐器、歌曲等等。

◆ 熊牧场 参观北海道代表动物『棕熊』一脸让人疼爱的模样，现场可以自费购买苹果喂熊。这里的熊由于都已习惯游客们的喂食，所以会摆出各种可爱逗趣的姿势来吸引游客们的注意~

### 3 洞爷湖🚗函馆 (早午餐)

◆ 百年女子修道院 建于西元1898年，法国派遣八名修女来此传道时所建的女子修道院，修道院及其庭园构成洋溢着浓郁的欧洲气息，院内有资料展示室，展示当年修女传道的生涯事迹。



◆ 五棱郭公园 五棱郭是江户时代建造的一个星形要塞城堡，是日本第一座西洋式城堡，外廓呈五角星形，建于1864年。

◆ 金森仓库群 为明治时代的红砖仓库，已改为各有特色的卖场，流行、可爱、梦幻般的各式各样杂货物品，在这里挑选专属于您的独特纪念品，此地接触西洋文化比其他地方都早。

◆ 函馆山(星空缆车) 百万夜景 被列为世界三大夜景，标高三百三十四公尺，函馆的夜景以特殊的扇型著称，是游函馆不能不去的景观。(含缆车)

### 4 函馆🚗登别 (早午餐)

◆ 函馆朝市 逛逛北海道最具代表性的海鲜市场，各式各样的海鲜目不暇给。美食街里的餐厅，摆着数不清的餐点模型样品，令人垂涎，也可以自费品尝海胆盖饭、鱼卵盖饭、螃蟹锅物..等等，别再想了！您一定要来此一游。

◆ 昆布馆 昆布就是日语的海带，主要就是介绍各类的海带，以及昆布的制作方式。

◆ 尼克斯海洋公园 北欧风格的海洋公园，外观模仿Egeskov Castle为蓝图兴建的海洋生态馆是巨大的鱼类展示馆，共有400种、1万隻以上的生物。精彩的海豚海狮秀及企鹅散步千万不要错过。

◆ 企鹅大游行表演 成群的企鹅左摇右晃游行在步道上，模样煞是可爱。



◆ 登别地狱谷 是登别温泉的水源。大约1万年前，日和山火山爆发形成的火口痕迹，即为今日直径450公尺、面积约11公顷的登别温泉地狱谷。

### 2 Chitose → Noboribetsu Lake Toya (L,D)

◆ **Noboribetsu Date Jidaimura Theme Park** A history theme park highlighting the Edo Period, one of the most attractive era in Japanese history.

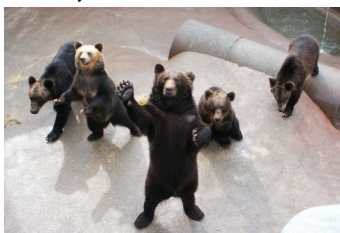


◆ **Ninja Show** History's famous Ninja is the star of Kasumi Ninja House, where you can relive the exciting times of the Ninja through the action show.

◆ **Shiraoi Ainu Museum** one of the country's best museums about the Ainu, the indigenous people of northern Japan. Each of the houses at Porotokotan demonstrates different aspects of Ainu culture and lifestyle. One of the larger houses holds a free, hourly performance with traditional Ainu folk dances, songs and mouth harp demonstrations.

◆ **Bear Ranch** Around 100 brown bears reside in the bear ranch. You can buy a couple of bags of apples and cookies to feed them. They'll wave at you, begging you to throw them either an apple or a cookie.

### 3 Lake Toya → Hakodate (B,L,D)

◆ **Trappistine Monastery** Japan's first convent, established in the 19th century. Its museum exhibits photos of people living in the monastery.



◆ **Goryokaku Park** is a massive, star shaped, Western style citadel, which was built in the last years of the Edo Period for the defense of Hakodate against the imperialist threat posed by the Western powers.

◆ **Kanemori Red Brick Ware-houses** The first commercial ware-house in Hakodate, has witnessed the

history of the city through its warehousing business. As one of the symbols of the Hakodate bay area that still reminds us much of the early days of the shipping industry, Kanemori Red Brick Warehouse will continue to witness the history of Hakodate forever and offer every visitor a beautiful, unforgettable time.

◆ **Mount Hakodate Night View** (Include Cable Car) night view from the summit is renowned in Japan as one of the best in the country, and one of the three in the world along with Hong Kong and Naples.

◆ **Check in Onsen Hotel**

### 4 Hakodate → Noboribetsu (B,L,D)

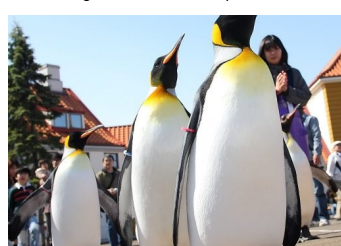
◆ **Hakodate Morning Market** If there's one thing you can't miss when visiting Hokkaido, it's their seafood! Fatty salmon and tuna, sweet hairy and king crab, and amazing squid sashimi are among what tourists from Japan and overseas always rave about when in Hokkaido.



◆ **Seaweed Museum** a place where you can "feel and experience everything about kelp".

◆ **Noboribetsu Marine Park Nixe Aquarium** with a variety of marine life, plus underwater tunnels & dolphin shows. Do not miss out to see adorable penguins wobbling within a designated route in the park.

◆ **Penguin Parade** Do not miss out to see adorable penguins wobbling within a designated route in the park.



◆ **Jigokudani Valley** is a spectacular, appropriately named valley just above the town of Noboribetsu Onsen, which displays hot steam vents, sulfurous streams and other volcanic activity.

### 5 Noboribetsu → Otaru Sapporo (B,L,D)

◆ **Otaru Canal** was a central part of the city's busy port in the first half of the 20th century. The canal became obsolete when modern dock facilities allowed for direct unloading of larger vessels. Thanks to a citizens' movement, a part of the canal was beautifully restored in the 1980s instead of being landfilled, while the warehouses were transformed into museums, shops and restaurants.



◆ **Craft Museum**  
◆ **Shiroyo Koibito Chocolate Park** Hokkaido most famous white chocolate's dessert.  
◆ **Kitaichi Glassware Shop** is a long-established handmade glassware shop, is one of the main tourist attractions of the city.  
◆ **Music Box Workshop** is one of the largest museum shops of music boxes in Japan.

### 6 Sapporo (B,L,D)

◆ **Clock Tower Building** is a wooden structure and well-known local tourist attraction, the building is of American-style building in Sapporo.

◆ **Odori Park** means "large street" in Japanese. It stretches east to west through Nishi 1 chome, Odori to Nishi 12 chome, Odori and divides the city into north and south sections.

◆ **Former Hokkaido Government Office Building** Hokkaido's best-known symbol and the red star on its exterior wall is the symbol of the Hokkaido Development Commission.

◆ **Ramen Yokocho** is the side street, which made Miso Ramen famous all over Japan. Today, there are 17 shops. All ramen shops are famous for representing Hokkaido, and some of them are even listed in the 2012 Michelin guide.

◆ **Sapporo/Asahi Beer Factory**

◆ **Tanukikoji Shopping Street**
